**Correspondence:**

On July 8, a public nurse from Bergen County Dept of Health Svc sent an invitation for a free memory screening for the seniors of HP. The memory screening is offered by a foundation called Act Now, a non-for-profit. The program consist of a presentation that last between 30 minutes and one hour. The screening section takes about 30 minutes and an appointment is required. Upon discussion the Board determined to find out the steps taken by Act Now if screening showed concern for memory.

On July 18, we received an email from the ShopRite in Northvale, offering a flu clinic. We told them we already have an arrangement with CVS Pharmacy Northvale, however

if ShopRite were able to come to an evening meeting of the 1st Responders, for those who are not able to attend our October 2nd flu clinic, we can forward ShopRite's offer to the 1st responders. Upon discussion the Board determined to forward ShopRite's offer of an evening-on-site-flu-clinic to the Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Volunteer Fire Department, and Police Department.

On July 24, we received an invoice for \$70 from the Hillsdale Board of Health for two HP children whom attended a Child Health Conference. We are contracted with them to conduct Child Health Conferences.

On July 27, a temporary food license was issued to Carmine's Pizza Factory, a food truck, that was selling food at an event at Highland Fields basketball courts. HP was hosting the championship games of a summer basketball tournament.

On July 31, a resident filed a request for rabies examination for a feral groundhog that was killed by their dog. The results were negative.

On August 26, Bergen County Department of Health Services sent an email to see if Harrington Park is interested in having them staff a flu clinic in town. They only offer the Quadrivalent vaccine, no high dose, beginning the last week of October.

Also on August 26, Karen Wolujewicz replied to our thank you for her attendance at our March Board of Health meeting to speak about measles. She was happy to hear her presentation was well received and asked for a copy of the March 2019 Minutes.

### **Reports:**

#### **Gail Poling, Town Nurse (read by Board Secretary)**

There are no Adult Health Clinics held during the months of July and August. They resume on September 11 at Borough Hall and September 13th at Club 60.

#### **Louis Apa, Sanitarian**

- A permit for rodent baiting was approved. They will also test for oil leakage and containment from previous land usage.
- An Amazon driver was bit while delivering a package. The dog was quarantined and released.
- A resident on Lincoln Terrace complained of dog droppings on their property, but it may be due to deer.
- Donatello's Restaurant, formerly Dino's, passed preliminary inspection.
- The Swim Club was inspected twice and found to be Satisfactory.
- More information will be gathered on whether Allegro will have their own ambulance corps, and whether an ambulance stretcher will fit their elevators and be able to turn on ramps.
