Any rental, lease, or sale of any residential use will require the owner to apply and secure a **Certificate of Continued Occupancy** from the **HP Building Department**. *This inspection is in addition to the Smoke Detector/Carbon Monoxide Certificate also filed through the Building Department.*

Fire Prevention

As we enter the Fall season, Please keep the following in your mind.

1. Change your Smoke alarm and your carbon Monoxide batteries when you turn your clocks back. Getting into the habit of changing the batteries at this time will insure that your devices will work properly.
2. If you are using live holiday decorations in your home, this season, please make sure you water them daily and remove them from your home at the 1st sign of drying out. A fire could result if you do not properly water them on a regular basis.
3. Check all Holiday lights for wear. If they look bad, replace them. This is a cause for fire if not properly inspected by you.

From the Mayor's Desk ...

OUR ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCE INVENTORY COMPLETED

I thank the efforts of Peter Ardito, the Chair of our Environmental Commission, and Michael Hakim, the Borough Planner. Now, the Borough has a very comprehensive Environmental Resource Inventory.

The document will be of great value to the Mayor and Council, Planning Board, and Board of Adjustment. It is also available at the Borough Hall, Library and will be on the Harrington Park website.

The inventory provides information and maps related to topography and slopes, soil classifications, FEMA, floodplains, surface water resources, hydrography and watersheds, environmentally sensitive areas and property ownership, maps for privately owned property, Borough owned property, and Suez owned property.

I am very grateful to Peter Ardito and the Environmental Commission, for pursuing this project, and Mike Hakim, who prepared the document. It took us a while to get the job done, but I'm sure you will agree, it was well worth the time, effort and cost.

CHANGES IN OUR POLICE DEPARTMENT

Over the summer, two of our police officers indicated they would be leaving the Harrington Park Police Force. Officer Danny Lim has accepted employment with the Bergen County Prosecutor's Office. Officer Jacob Miller is moving to Florida, and will serve in law enforcement in his new location. I thank both officers for the time they served the residents of Harrington Park and wish them well in their new pursuits.

As a result of these two departures, the Mayor and Council has hired two new officers. Officer James LaVigna returns to Harrington Park after spending several years in the Township of Rochelle Park. We have also hired Officer Michael Getto, who is an experienced police officer from the Borough of Norwood.

You can be assured that the safety and security of our residents remains a paramount concern of the Mayor and Council.
