RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE OF CONTINUED OCCUPANCY REQUIRED

Any rental, lease, or sale of any residential use will require the owner to apply and secure a **Certificate of Continued Occupancy** from the **HP Building Department**. *This inspection is in addition to the Smoke Detector/Carbon Monoxide Certificate also filed through the Building Department.*

Message from the Fire Marshal Thomas E. Simpson

Please check the batteries in your Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide alarms. Change them when we change the clocks back to Eastern Standard Time. This also applies to those that are hardwired and interconnected with battery back-up.

As the Holidays get closer, now is the time to check those holiday lights for worn, or damaged wires including all animated accessories that you put on display.

All business owners. The NJ State Fire Code requires that if you have a fuel burning appliance, boiler, furnace or hot water heater you are required to have a carbon monoxide detector installed inside your place of business.. Beginning October 1, this requirement will be enforced.



FROM THE MAYOR'S DESK ...

H.P. - CLOSTER BRIDGE WORK

As everyone in our immediate area knows, work is underway at the intersection of Livingston Street, Closter Road, Knickerbocker Road and Harrington Avenue. There have been some delays as a result of environmental issues and concerns, but work continues. The completion of the project is still scheduled for November 1, 2018.

I want to thank our residents for their patience and understanding in dealing with the required detours. This is a Bergen County project which has been under consideration for decades. I appreciate the fact that the County is working with us to move the project along.

UPDATE ON THE ALLEGRO PROJECT

It is anticipated that the Allegro Group will be breaking ground at the SUEZ Water property on Old Hook Road early this fall. They will construct a facility that will provide 55 and older market rental units, assisted living units and memory loss units.

The structure will include state of the art features and outstanding eye appeal overlooking the reservoir. At this time we cannot give you a date for the actual opening of the development, but I will keep you updated as we move forward.


