RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE OF CONTINUED OCCUPANCY REQUIRED

Any rental, lease, or sale of any residential use will require the owner to apply and secure a **Certificate of Continued Occupancy** from the **HP Building Department**. *This inspection is in addition to the Smoke Detector/Carbon Monoxide Certificate also filed through the Building Department.*

Message from the Fire Marshal Thomas E. Simpson

All living holiday decorations should be removed by this time. Please change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors now!

Do not store gasoline inside you home or garage, do not store the snow blower or lawn mower or any other machine with gasoline inside you basement or garage.

Be very careful when refueling. Make sure you turn off the mower first then refuel.

All businesses are required by the State Fire Code to have installed inside a carbon monoxide detector if there is a fuel burning appliance inside your business (Gas furnace, Gas Hot water heater, Propane fired furnace, propane fired hot water heater, or an attached garage). A battery operated unit is approved.





## FROM THE MAYOR'S DESK ...

### SCHOOL SAFETY IN HARRINGTON PARK

On Monday, March 5th, I was one of three mayors who attended Assemblywoman Schepisi's Community Roundtable on Gun Laws and School Safety in New Jersey. The speakers included representations for the Bergen County Police Chiefs Association, the N.J. School Boards Association, the N.J. Association of School Resource Officers, private school safety experts, educators, school superintendents, Senator Cardinale and Assemblyman Auth.

The information was informative and very timely. Please know much of what I heard has already been done in our grade school. The work of Dr. Fried and his staff, as well as Chief Maalouf and our Police Department, puts us ahead of the curve on school safety. We will continue to work on additional procedures to maintain the highest level of security in our local school. To that end, we will be meeting later this month to review our current plan and consider other options that would improve safety standards and protocols. Please know the safety of your children or grandchildren is a top priority for all of us.

### WHAT A DISGRACE!

While I continue to seek reasons for the power outages we experienced during the week of March 6, 2018, I want to thank those affected for your patience and understanding. Based on the absence of a timely response from O&R to speed up the process, I had discussions with a representative from Governor Murphy's office, a representative from Congressman Gottheimer's office, Assemblyman Auth and communications with Assemblywoman Schepisi. To their credit, each helped to apply pressure on O&R to speed up the process.

Even though the crisis is over, I still want a full and definite response as to what caused this unusual delay.

On a positive note, I have heard so many stories about neighbors helping neighbors in so many different ways. It's this type of cooperation that makes Harrington Park such a wonderful place to call home.

### HARRINGTON PARK AWARDED A NJDOT GRANT

The New Jersey Department of Transportation has notified us that we will be receiving a grant in the amount of \$218,000 for the repairing of portions of Hackensack Avenue and Kline Street. In addition, we are working with the Riverside Co-op to repave several other roadways in town. Based on the expensive nature of roadway work, our securing of grants and working with Riverside Co-op help keep our costs down. We will continue to seek some economic assistance where ever possible.

### JOINT INSURANCE FUND PLATINUM AWARD

At the J.I.F. Safety Breakfast on March 6th, 2018, the Borough of Harrington Park received the Platinum Award for a perfect score in matters related to **SAFETY PROCEDURES** in Harrington Park. As a result, we received a check in the amount of \$2,500 from J.I.F. In addition to Harrington Park, Alpine, Upper Saddle River and Wyckoff were also honored for perfect scores.


### PLEASE DRIVE WITH CARE
