AUGUST 10-18<sup>TH</sup>, 2016**



***INFORMATION SESSION: JANUARY 10<sup>TH</sup>, 2016***

The Community Church of Harrington Park will be going to the Dominican Republic this summer to do work hand in hand with the local people. The trip is being coordinated through FOUNDATION FOR PEACE, a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization founded in 2002. Foundation for Peace works with impoverished areas to build medical clinics, water treatment facilities, churches, and schools, as well as providing much-needed medical care. The organization's emphasis is on establishing partnerships with the local people, while helping them **and** trip participants to grow their spiritual foundations. As there is much to accomplish, the motto of Foundation for Peace is: "We can't do everything, but we'll do anything!"

**FOUNDATION FOR PEACE** mission trips typically consist of 15-25 people, ages 5 to 65+. Our group will stay at accommodations near the community we'll serve. In addition to building one of the facilities mentioned above alongside community members, there will be worship at local churches, children's ministry activities (including Vacation Bible School), community outreach (baseball or soccer games), medical outreach (there is something for everyone to do, regardless of technical ability), group devotions and a day of recreation (such as going to a local beach).

Following are the trip basics:


**DATES:** August 10-18, 2016

**COST:** \$1140 per person plus airfare, which includes travel within the Dominican Republic, meals, lodging, construction materials and medical personnel. Round-trip airfare is approximately \$400, based upon departure location. There will be the possibility for partially subsidizing the cost of the trip through church fundraisers.
