### **MORTGAGE & FORECLOSURE INFORMATION**

I have asked that fact sheets and basic information related to mortgage problems be copied and made available for everyone at Borough Hall. This information has been provided by both State and County agencies. If you know anyone who would benefit from this type of information, let us know. The most dangerous thing for someone confronted with this type of problem is to do nothing.

### **BUDGET REVIEW BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL**

Work has already started on our 2009 Municipal Budget. Based on information from Trenton, we will probably see drastic cuts in State aid to municipalities. As a result, the Mayor and Council will review each line in our budget with the hope of trying to make cuts to off set the loss of State funds.

## **ORDINANCES**

### **INTRODUCED & PASSED**

**#634-**(First Reading) Ordinance dealing with the establishment of development fees in the Borough.

**#631-**(Second Reading) Ordinance amending other Borough ordinances to include additional items required to be recycled by State statutes.

**#632-**(Second Reading) Ordinance amending the anti-discrimination policy found in the Borough Employee Manual.

**#633-**(Second Reading) Ordinance to establish limitations with respect to door-to-door canvassing by non-profit and/or public interest groups.

All of the above ordinances are available for your review at Borough Hall.

### **OUR C.O.A.H. PLAN APPROVED**

HP was required under current State of New Jersey to provide forty-one (41) affordable housing units. In order to be protected for the law suits and meet State requirements, our plan must be approved by the Borough and submitted to the Council on Affordable Housing by December 31, 2008.

The Planning Board has approved such a plan and it was endorsed by the Mayor and Council in November. While we are submitting a plan, the Borough is challenging the rational that established the 41 units required by the State. Our challenge is based on three points which we feel will eventually lower our requirements.

Our plan and challenge are available for your review at Borough Hall. The plan was developed by Hakim Associates. Mr. Hakim is a licensed planner and a resident of Harrington Park.
