
HP Teens for Tomorrow

From the Mayor's Desk....

OUR FIRST GRADERS ACCEPTED THE CHALLENGE

With the cooperation of Dr. Fried and our school officials, I submitted an application to the New Jersey League of Municipalities Educational Foundation, Inc. to take part in the Mayor's Book Club. We have been notified of our acceptance and as a result, our first grade students are asked to read at least 1000 books between February 1, 2015 and May 1, 2015. If they reach that goal, the school will receive \$1000 to spend on the first grade classroom library.

On Wednesday, January 28, 2015, I met with our first graders and read to them as our kick off event. I plan on joining them on several other occasions to read and further encourage their efforts. If you have a child in the first grade or know a first grade student, please offer your encouragement. This is a great program and worthy of our support

RAILROAD SAFETY IN HARRINGTON PARK

Early in 2014, I hosted a meeting at Borough Hall for all Mayors, Fire Chiefs, Police Chiefs and Emergency Management Coordinators concerned with various issues related to CSX train traffic through all the towns along the tracks from the New York border to the Township of Teaneck. Speed, length of each train, as well as what is being transported on these rails are under review.

Since that meeting, other meetings have been held and support is growing. The latest meeting which took place January 4, 2015, in Old Tappan, was very productive and well attended. All of our elected officials from Legislative District #39 were in attendance and were very supportive.

Since the railroad is regulated by our Federal Government, I recently sent letters to our US Senators, Menendez and Booker asking them for their help in promoting better safety conditions. Hopefully, I will be able to share with you some good news related to this issue in the near future.

NO HELP FROM TRENTON THIS YEAR

As in the past, I recently attended the New Jersey Conference of Mayors Winter Summit in Trenton. My main question was related to real property tax reform. New Jersey remains one of the few states that still relies on property tax to pay for education expenses, which accounts for 70% of our budget in Harrington Park.

My suggestion that a broad-base tax, like the income tax or sales tax, be used to help fund education, was not well received. The use of a broad-base tax would be helpful, especially for our senior residents who are living on fixed incomes.

I plan to follow up on this issue with letters to all our representatives in the 39th Legislative District. Hopefully, they may be able to assist in changing an outdated and unfair tax structure. I'll keep you updated in the future.

The County official in charge of the system saw fit to reject my request, because in his opinion, it was not an emergency worthy of a Reverse 911 message.

As a result, the only people we were able to reach were those who registered their email address with us through our Borough website. We have recently updated emails that were provided on pet registrations. If you would like to be included in future notifications, you may register through the INSTANT INFO link at the end of the right hand column on our webpage at harringtonparknj.gov. This is safe and secure, and the addresses are private. Follow the easy instructions– you will receive a confirmation email to which you should respond. 


